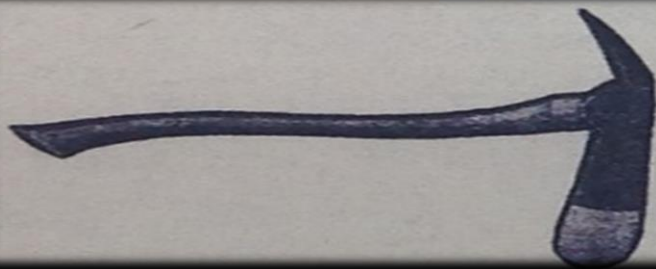

ice tools from his own collection!*



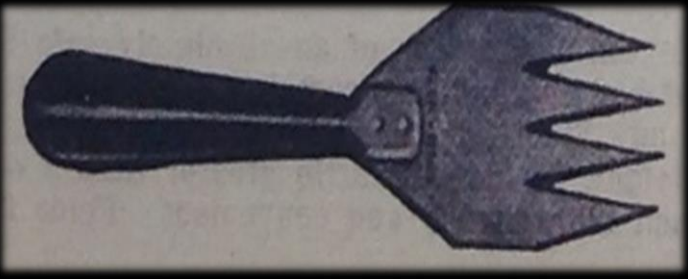
